## Welcome to the 2021 Camping Season

**Park opens on April 15<sup>th</sup>**



**Park Infrastructure:** As Spider Lake Springs Resort has evolved and grown over the years, so has the impact to the septic system. The Park has contracted the services of a local company to assist in the upgrading, rebuilding and maintenance of the system. It is imperative that all campers do their part to ensure that this expensive system is respected by never, ever flushing anything but paper.

The wonderful park staff have been very busy over the winter months. Parking areas have been revamped and expanded. There is now no reason to park on roadsides or overstay time limits in short term parking areas. The fire hose boxes have been rebuilt and upgraded to help ensure everyone's safety within the park. Work has been done on the play field sprinklers. Dangerous trees have been removed. Proper drain pipes have been installed to prevent roads from flooding in the winter months. The dog park and pond are being upgraded.

**Staffing:** Currently SLS employs a full time manager, Brian Lamb, and three part-time employees. Plans are in the works to secure a grant for a full time summer student. Look for more information coming regarding the on-site security personnel.

**Social Committee:** Most social events in 2020 were cancelled due to Covid. This year the committee is

Future items currently being researched are the cost of installing Wi-Fi throughout the park and upgrading the electrical services to 50-amp service.
