#### **Smoking:**

As per the laws of British Columbia there is no smoking of any sort allowed in areas frequented by children. Therefore, there is no smoking allowed at the ponds, tennis courts, clubhouse or longhouse. As well, as per the laws of British Columbia the smoking of tobacco products, cannabis or vaping products are not allowed at indoor public places, in vehicles, on boats and within six meters of any doorway, window or air intake. Please be courteous to other campers and properly dispose of your butts, do not litter.

#### **Right To Uninterrupted Enjoyment:**

**10.9** With the exception of home-based craft sales, no person shall conduct any commercial or business activity on or from any designated campsite. No person may erect any commercial signs or advertising on a designated campsite other than "For sale" signs which must be contained within their site.

**10.10** Soliciting, within the Resort, is strictly prohibited.

##### **Gardening and general pruning/cleanup**

The general landscaping and beautification of the common areas is handled currently by 10 to 12 volunteers (Park owners) with oversight by the Park Manager, who is developing a section-by-section group of volunteers to beautify and maintain each section. **Bottle Recycling** The Park needs volunteers to help with sorting cans and bottles for pick up by Bottle Depot truck, as well as loading the truck when it is here. Sorting can take time, so many helping hands makes it easier. Gloves and recycle bags will be provided. We can re-open the bottle recycling as soon as we have enough volunteers. In the past the funds collected have been approximately \$4,500 per year.
