Garbage Bins: There have been some issues. Responsible and ethical use of the garbage and recycling bins are important. Your cooperation is required. Garbage bins are for regular household garbage only. Basically, the items that you would put into your garbage can **inside** your trailer. No items are to be placed on the ground outside the garbage bins. It is your responsibility to take items to the appropriate recycling or disposal centers yourself. Detailed information is on the website. If you have items that you are no longer using and you think someone else may like to use you can leave the item at the edge of your campsite with a free sign on it **while you are at the Springs only**, if there are no takers by the time you go home you must remove the item from the roadside.

Dogs: Campers are responsible to clean up after them. All dogs must be kept on a leash when outside of your campsite and secured within your campsite. This is for the safety of all the beloved pets in the park. Keep reading for exciting news about the 2 dog parks, where your pet can be off leash as long as you are abiding by all posted rules.

Security Staff: Please give a warm welcome to Dave Olson, our new on-site Security personnel. Dave's previous firefighting experience and first aid skills make him a great asset to have at the Springs. When other staff are not on duty the Security position provides

24 hour emergency response. Dave will be conducting evening and weekend security checks and provide telephone assistance and radio backup for the staff.

Park Improvements: Recent improvements to the Dog Pond include clearing some of the alder trees away from the edge of the water to prevent debris in the water. Fencing is being installed along that side of the pond to provide a more secure area for pets. A new waterline into the pond will provide fresh water. New benches are being installed. Over the winter the Dog Park had to be dug up for the repairs to the septic system. Now the dog run area is being raked to level it and the fencing will be replaced in stages over the summer including a double gate entrance.
