Did You Know? Our septic system can only handle toilet paper that's septic-safe. Please check the packaging before purchasing. Do not flush anything other than septic-approved TP—no other paper products, diapers, feminine products, or foreign objects.

Avoid using harsh liquids like bleach, antibacterial soaps, petroleum-based materials (e.g., paints, thinners), or even vinegar, as these can damage the system. Misuse may lead to costly repairs.

Also, our camp shares a limited supply of electricity and water. Please conserve during peak times by avoiding high-consumption activities like pressure washing or excessive air conditioning, especially on busy weekends. Winterizing an RV: If you're new to winterizing an RV, don't worry—your owner's manual is a great place to start, and the internet is full of helpful tips and step-bystep guides. Just a heads-up: water in the park is turned off from October 15 to April 15, so be sure to take care of everything before then!
